Crosshair is a leading junior exploration company focused on exploring and developing uranium in the Central Mineral Belt of Labrador. An aggressive drill program is currently underway with the objective of rapidly expanding a 43-101 uranium resource.

Crosshair is also demonstrating the multi-deposit potential of the project by successfully developing and drilling several new uranium targets on the 720 square kilometre project.

As exploration advances within the Crosshair project, along with various other exploration plays in the area, the Central Mineral Belt is fast emerging as the next big uranium district in Canada.

Crosshair also continues to advance its gold and Volcanic Hosted Massive Sulphide (VHMS) projects in Newfoundland, which are slated for a dividend spin out to shareholders in 2008.

## Exploration Highlights

### Central Mineral Belt (Uranium)

Over 50,000m of drilling to date and an additional 13,000m of proposed drilling for winter 2008

#### C Zone

- Contains an **NI 43-101** indicated resource of 3.19 million pounds of uranium and an additional inferred resource of 4.59 million pounds of uranium
- Resource remains open along strike and depth

#### Area 1

- Similar Style of uranium mineralization and geologic setting to C Zone
- 2007 drilling returned excellent results

#### New Targets

- Drilling and exploration work identified several new targets: Moran Heights, Area 51, Area 1, Armstrong, Croteau Lake, Blue Star, and Madsen Lake

### Golden Promise (Gold ) and Victoria Lake (VHMS)

- **Golden Promise** extended the Jaclyn Zone by more than 50% to 800m and the zone remains open along strike
- **Victoria Lake** drilling intercepted strong VHMS style alteration in volcanic rocks, potentially indicative of a proximal massive sulphide system.
- Golden Promise and Victoria Lake are slated for dividend spin-out for Crosshair shareholders

### Central Mineral Belt Uranium Project (2008)

The newly created Lonestar Division will spearhead an extensive exploration program on the southern portion of the Property planned for the summer of 2008. Crosshair expects to have four drills turning with the option of two more drills, which will allow the Lonestar Division to test the largely unexplored southern half of the project and the Northstar Division to continue to increase the pounds of uranium at the C Zone and to define resources at other areas. New targets will be advanced to the drill stage through ground geophysics, geological mapping, and geochemistry.
